Polling in the 3rd phase of the Panchayat Elections 2018, being held in 9 phases, will take place on 24th November. As per the detailed schedule published on 22nd October 2018, the nomination process for 505 halqas having 3933 Panch constituencies commenced with the issuance of notification on 29th October 2018. While 96 Sarpanch and 1437 Panch have been elected unopposed, polling will take place for 358 sarpanch and 1652 panch seats, with 5239 candidates in fray. An electorate of 423592 will be voting for sarpanch constituencies while it is 270668 for panch constituencies. Photo Voter Slips have been distributed among the voters to inform them of their polling station. The district wise details are in the enclosed Annexure.

In this phase, 2773 polling stations are being set up - 918 in Kashmir Division and 1855 in Jammu Division. Of these, 727 have been categorized as Hypersensitive - 493 in Kashmir Division and 234 in Jammu Division. Basic Minimum Facilities (BMF) have been ensured in all the polling stations for facilitating the voters. Security arrangements have been made including deployment of Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF).

In the 2nd phase, the State has witnessed a polling % of 71.1% - in the Kashmir Division 52.2% and in the Jammu Division 80.4%. Re-poll was held for Ward No 06 of Panchayat Halqa Feller A, Block Thakrie, Kishtwar on 21st November and a turnout of 71.8% was recorded. Results have been announced for all these by the respective Returning Officers. Orders have been passed in various complaint cases as well as directions of the Hon'ble Courts and wherever necessary Notifications reappointing the election schedules have been issued. All such orders/notifications are available at website of CEO J&K.

As in the first two phases, for this phase too, in order to ensure free and fair polls, general observers, expenditure observers and micro observers have been appointed apart from magistrates. Control Rooms established in all the districts are responding to any complaints of violation of the Model Code of Conduct or any other election related matter. The legal provision of end of campaigning including public meetings, processions, etc. 48 hours before the hour fixed for the end of poll stands enforced in the areas going to poll. Necessary orders pertaining to declaration of dry day have also been issued.

The timing of poll is from 8 am to 2 pm. The State Government has declared holiday on the day of poll, including under the Negotiable Instruments Act, and, therefore, it is enjoined upon all establishments, whether Government or Private to observe the same strictly. Also, provision of Special casual leave for state government employees has been made. Central government offices shall also afford reasonable facility to its employees who desire to vote.

The Chief Electoral Officer, J&K appeals to the voters to come forward and exercise their right to franchise in order to choose their local self government to address their local needs.
