# PRESS NOTE

## PANCHAYAT ELECTIONS:-

The last General Elections to the Panchayats were held in the year 2011, after a gap of 10 years, through secret ballot. The Panchayats elected in the year 2011 completed their tenure in July, 2016.

The powers to determine and delimit Halqa Panchayat, Preparation of Panchayat Electoral Rolls and conduct of elections are vested with the Chief Electoral Officer, J&K as Election Authority under J&K Panchayati Raj Act, 1989 through the Jammu & Kashmir Panchayati Raj (Amendment) Act, 2018 dated 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2018.

## PREPARATION OF PANCHAYAT ELECTORAL ROLL:-

The Election Authority has published Draft Panchayat Electoral Rolls on 18<sup>th</sup> of August, 2018 with reference to 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2018 as the qualifying date, for inviting claim & objections. The finalisation of the Panchayat Electoral Rolls is under way & Final Electoral Rolls are likely to be published by end of this month. As per Draft Electoral Rolls, the number of Blocks/Panchayats /Panch Constituencies in the Panchayat Halqas alongwith number of electorates is given as under:-

### **RESERVATION OF CONSTITUENCIES:-**

Notification with regard to reservation of Sarpanch/Panch Constituencies for Schedule Caste, Schedule Tribes and Women as per provision of the Act and Rules governing Panchayat Elections have been issued by the competent authority i.e., Directors of Rural Development Department, J&K.

### **POLLING STATIONS:-**

Suitable number of polling stations shall be notified for each Panch Constituency of a Panchayat Halqa as determined by the District Panchayat Election Officer (Deputy Commissioner), after final publication of Panchayat Electoral Rolls.

### **BALLOT BOXES:-**

Ballot boxes would be used during the forthcoming Panchayat Elections, 2018. Sufficient numbers of ballot boxes are being made available for the smooth conduct of the elections.

### **BALLOT PAPERS:-**

In view of the recent amendments making direct elections to Sarpanch, the electors shall cast their votes for the Panch as well as Sarpanch. For this purpose, two separate colours of ballot papers shall be used.

### **VOTER SLIPS:-**

To facilitate the voters to know where he/she is enrolled as a voter at a particular polling station and what is his/her S.No in the electoral roll, voter slips will be distributed to all enrolled voters. The voter slips shall be in Urdu and English language.

### **ELECTORS PHOTO IDENTITY CARDS (EPIC)/ALTERNATE DOCUMENTS:-**

The Election Authority has decided that compulsory identification of voters will be made in the Panchayats Elections. Electors who have already been provided with EPIC shall be identified through EPIC only. However the Election Authority has also notified a list of alternative documents which can also be used for the purpose of identification, by the electors who are yet to be provided EPICs.

### **POSTAL BALLOTS:-**

In order to facilitate the Kashmiri migrant voters, a scheme to enable them to vote through Postal Ballot is being provided in the Panchayat Elections.

### **OBSERVERS:-**

General Observer shall be deployed to ensure free and fair Panchayat Elections. The observer will be asked to keep a close watch on every stage of the electoral process. Their names, addresses within the district and their telephone numbers will be publicized. In addition to Micro Observers shall be deployed to observe the poll proceeding in the Polling stations on the Poll day.

### **ELECTION EXPENDITURE MONITORING:-**

Comprehensive instructions for the purpose of effective monitoring of the election expenditure of the candidates have been issued. Expenditure Observers are being appointed to keep close watch on Election Expenditure of the candidate. Control Room and complaint monitoring centre shall be operative during the entire election process. All the candidates have to ensure that they maintain day-to-day expenditure record in the prescribed register, which will be supplied to the contesting candidate in the form of '**Expenditure Register**', from the date of nomination to the date of declaration of result. The Election Authority has fixed the limits of expenditure to be incurred by the Contesting Candidate as under:-

For election to Sarpanch	-	Rs 20000/-
For election to Panch	-	Rs.5000/-

### **VIDEOGRAPHY:-**

All critical event will be videographed. District Panchayat Election Officers (Deputy Commissioners) will arrange sufficient numbers of video and digital cameras and camera teams for the purpose. The events for videography will include filing of nomination, scrutiny thereof and allotment of symbols, storage and distribution of Ballot Boxes, important public meetings, processions, etc., during campaign, process of dispatching of postal ballot papers, polling process and counting of votes.

## MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT:-

With the announcement of this Schedule for the conduct of Panchayat Elections through this Press Note, provision of the Model Code of Conduct shall come into force with immediate effect. All the provisions of the Model Code will apply to all the Panchayat Halqas (Rural Areas) and will be applicable to all the candidates, political parties and the State/Central Government.

## SCHEDULE:-

In terms of Jammu & Kashmir Panchayati Raj Rules, 1996, the Government in Rural Development Department J&K has issued Notification calling upon all the Panchayat Halqas in the State to elect Sarpanches and Panches vide its SRO No.405 dated 16<sup>th</sup> September, 2018.

Election Authority, J&K has prepared the Schedule for holding of Panchayat Elections, 2018, which is as under:-
